Festival Rules

The Wavelength Music and Arts Festival presenters intend to provide a safe environment. Please be aware of the following rules and recommendations:

Point of Entrance:

- You must have a ticket to enter the festival grounds. All tickets, including online tickets will be scanned at the gate. Wristbands will be distributed to allow ticket-holders to leave and re-enter the grounds.
- Tickets will be available for purchase at the gate.
- Tickets will scan only once. Lost or stolen tickets will not be replaced. All ticket sales will be final.
- Bring valid ID's for ticket verification.
- Children under 5 years of age may attend for free, and must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Attendees may be asked to reveal contents of bags and containers. Lack of cooperation is cause for your departure without refund.

Beer Tent/Adult Beverages

- A valid government-issued photo ID is required to purchase alcoholic beverages on festival grounds. Attendees will need to show their ID to festival security in order to receive a wristband that will allow them to purchase alcohol.
- Sales of alcohol will end promptly at 10:30pm. There are NO REFUNDS for unused tickets.
- No alcoholic beverages may be brought into the festival.
- The beer tent area is a smoke-free zone! as prescribed by recently passed legislation

Other Prohibited items

- Tents, flags, knives, or other weapons are prohibited.
- No glass or breakable containers are allowed.
- Video cameras, audio recording devices, professional cameras(No cameras without detachable lenses) are allowed.
- No pets are allowed.
- Bikes must be parked outside of the festival grounds

These items are allowed

- Non-professional digital & film cameras, disposable cameras.
- Fanny packs, sealed bottled water, backpacks, satchels (medium-sized,) hats, sun block, lighters, sunglasses.

Security and Safety

- Our local police officers and security officers will be on duty to ensure safety. Officer Friendly is cool but plays by the rules...so should you!

Weather

- The Wavelength Music and Arts Festival will take place, rain or shine.

Lost and Found

- We will do our best to collect lost items. Report and retrieve items at the WRHC entrance. Please leave your favorite bling at home!
